ABOUT BUILD & REPAIR CORPS

Habitat Build & Repair Corps is an 11 or 6 - month training program through AmeriCorps service that prepares members for a job in the construction trade. Members of all backgrounds are welcome and need not have any previous experience in construction. Instructors will guide members in training projects, site safety, and hands-on home building. Working alongside volunteers and professionals, members will have the skills and confidence to be placed in an industry position.

- Construction Crew Members participate in 6 - 11 months of hands-on training (900 - 1700 hours).
- Main job site: Pittsfield, MA.

Q&A

How old do I need to be to participate?

Minimum age is 17. There is no upper limit on age.

Do I need to have construction experience?

You do not need any prior experience. You will learn about tools, techniques, and safety while you work.

Do I need my own transportation?

Our team meets every morning at our main office, 314 Columbus Ave., Pittsfield. We provide transportation to and from the office to the construction site.

Do I need a degree?

You **do not** need a college degree to serve.
You **do** need a high school or GED education.

Will I get paid?

Yes, you will receive a modest living allowance throughout your term of service.
